A NEW CHAPTER FOR THE SCHOOL LIBRARY




The room was cleared shortly before Christmas and has since been painted and re-carpeted. Over the coming months, the newly whitewashed walls will be transformed with the addition of


a tremendous mural. The room will be also be furnished to create a special area to explore, relax and celebrate reading.

As part of our World Book Day celebrations, pupils were asked to create their own designs for a mural. We received a number of very creative ideas!


In addition to this, the children used their creativity to map out their floor-plans for the room itself. Again, we had some very imaginative proposals.








This design would make the new library feel more like a home than an old school classroom.
