KS2 Achievement, 2022-2023

Schools are required to publish their latest KS2 assessment data taken from the SATs tests that Year 6 children take each year.

The first table shows the proportion of children who achieved the expected standard and a higher level of attainment.

KS2	Number of pupils	Percentage of pupils
Reading	Expected+ 10/10 Greater depth 6/10	100% 60%
Writing	Expected+ 10/10 Greater depth 3/10	100% 30%
Mathematics	Expected+ 9/10 Greater depth 4/10	90% 40%
Grammar, punctuation and spelling	Expected+ 9/10 Greater depth 3/10	90% 30%
Combined	Expected+ 11/14 Greater depth 2/10	90% 20%

The second table shows the progress scores for the cohort as a whole. The average is 0 and measures are calculated based on the score each child achieved at KS1 (Year 2) and compared to other children across the country who achieved a similar score at KS1.

Reading	4.9
Writing	3.7
Maths	3.1

The third table shows the average scaled score for the cohort. Children must achieve a scaled score of 100 to pass the test and an average of 110 to achieve a higher level.

Reading	111
Writing	109
Maths	109

Please note: achievement information can be an indicator of the quality of teaching at a school but it can also be significantly skewed by a range of factors, particularly in a small school when the number of children is so few.
