Reading and Homework

Thank you for your continued support at home with your child's reading journey. Providing your child with many opportunities to read out loud as well as opportunities to be read to, forms an important part of strengthening their fluency and vocabulary which will support all areas of learning. To support this journey, we are excited to open our library to the children again. Children will be able to choose from a range of books in our library to take home every Monday along with their reading book and sharing book, please ensure these are well looked after and returned each week.

This term reading books will continue to be changed on Mondays. We have a box near the door of the classroom for the children to deposit their books. This should be done by the children at the start of the day.

Please sign your child's reading record every time they read. We have a reading challenge as a school and if 5 reads have been recorded for the week, your child will be recognised in celebration assembly each term.

The new spelling list will be sent home on Friday. Suggested activities for the White Rose 1-minute Maths app are listed below. These activities will support your child with their factual fluency.

PE:

This term PE will be on Mondays and Thursdays. Please ensure your child wears suitable PE kit to school on these days, including trainers.

Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly labelled.

Beatbus:

Last term the children began their Beatbus sessions with The Music Hub. These sessions focus on understanding the pulse and pitch of music and early notation recognition. The children enjoy these sessions and we look forward to continuing with them this term.
